

European Innovation Week Taiwan May 30th – June 3rd

More than 70% of the global economic growth is realised outside the EU. In order to support our companies and certainly the SME's to take advantage of this growth, Silicon Europe has defined an internationalisation strategy aiming to help our companies to identify and to take advantage of opportunities outside Europe.

Taiwan has been identified as one of the promising regions outside Europe for companies active on the value chain of micro- and nanotechnology, ICT or smart systems.

Although Taiwan may be less known to various regions in Europe than China or the United States, Taiwan offer a large potential of opportunities for the European ICT industry. In particular, Taiwan is renowned for the production of competitive ICT hardware coupled to being the world's largest producer of semiconductor components. Also Taiwan realises that innovation, the source of prosperity is becoming a global activity. Development of solutions for tomorrow's challenges in health, mobility, smart industry, smart agriculture, energy efficiency and communication/big data has led to changes in Governmental industrial policy towards more vertically and globally integrated value chains. To broaden the scope of Taiwanese companies, traditionally aiming at the United States and mainland China, the government also stimulates companies to explore the possibilities on European markets. One of the instruments here is a financial support to companies that join the European H2020 innovation program. All in all, this means that Taiwan is a more than interesting and promising region to explore for new commercial contacts.

Therefore Silicon Europe gladly invites you to join a mission to Taiwan to attend the "European Innovation Week". The European Innovation Week in Taiwan is co-organised by Silicon Europe Worldwide. The European Innovation Week offers you a broad programme including many opportunities to get acquainted with a manifold of Taiwanese companies, institutes and organisations. The Computex, the largest Asian ICT fair and counterpart of the CES, will be the venue for the event.

- Participation to the program is free of charge but registration is mandatory.

- Travel costs will not be compensated by the European Innovation Week organisation.
 - Depending on national or regional instruments you may be eligible for national or regional financial support. Contact you regional cluster representative for more information.
- As the European Innovation Week is organised in parallel with the Computex, fair hotel accommodation will be scarce. Especially for the European Week a limited amount of rooms have been reserved by the Taiwanese government. You are at liberty to make use of this reservation.
- For the first time, Computex is organising a starter's platform called Innovex. It is an initiative copied from the Eureka Park at CES (Las Vegas). It offers starters the possibility to showcase at a reasonable price: 1000 US\$ for 1.5m x 1.5m and 2000 US\$ for 3m x 3m.
