New Project Silicon Europe Worldwide | 01.01.2016 - 31.12.2017

European Innovation Week | 30.05.-03.06.2016

The European Innovation Week in Taiwan took place from May 30 until June 3. Nearly 100 people representing European organisations participated in the event. Additionally, more than 400 people representing the Taiwanese registered, clearly indicating the interest to collaborate with Europe. During this week, approximately 10 seminars were held along with a business matchmaking session during which over 250 participants brought together European and Taiwanese organisations. ** **more**

Next to the European Innovation Week, the project team achieved further success. Contacts to 16 different Taiwanese business support organisations were established. These include i.e. TAITRA (Taiwan External Trade Development Council) and SEMI Taiwan (Association of the Semiconductor Industry). In total, 37 European SMEs attended the organised events including the European Innovation Week. Ten of these have already established collaborations with Taiwan thanks to efforts made within the project.
